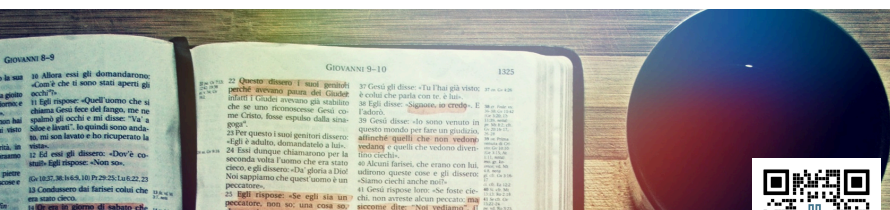

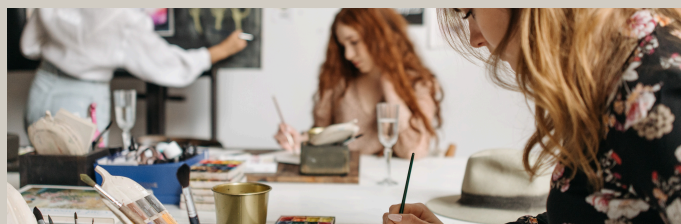
Fall Kickoff is on September 9
