SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

- The Israelites in Egypt were at their absolute worst, with the latest persecution from the Egyptians. How does God respond?
- Has God's response ever been in question in your own life? What should we remember when we are experiencing our worst?
- How can you know that God has a plan for your life? (vs1)
- How does knowing that God has a plan for your life help you when things are difficult?
- How can you know that God has not forgotten you? (vs2-vs6)
- Knowing that God has a glorious place for you can strengthen your resolve when you are struggling in your current place, why is that? (vs7-8)
- What does a life look like when it has no purpose?
- Have you ever felt as though you had no purpose in your life? How did you respond to that feeling?
- Who is able to help you understand your purpose? How do you understand it?
