

No Other gods: No Land gods (Exodus 8:16-9:12)

## SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

- The nation of Egypt had an established system of authority. Their gods, including Pharaoh, exerted influence in every area of their lives. Yaweh makes himself known through Moses and the first two plagues. How does Pharaoh respond?
- We have established systems of authority and there are elements of the world that exert influence in our lives. What elements of this world have the greatest influence on you?
- In the third and fourth plague we see the land gods of Egypt being overcome by God. How is God shown to be superior in these plagues?
- Why is it necessary for Egypt and its people to understand the superiority of God?
- Pharaoh responds to the fourth plague with a compromise, "worship your God in our land here"! Why was that an impossible solution to God?
- It would have been a compromise to worship Yaweh among the other gods of Egypt. The Israelites needed to leave Egypt and worship Yaweh. Sometimes it is necessary to separate from the world to worship God. Are there ways that you are still enmeshed with the world which prevent you from truly worshipping God?
- Pharaoh doubled down on his conviction that his gods were superior to Yaweh. This led to continued devastation for himself and his people. What are some ways that we believe the world and its counterfeits are superior to God? What is the outcome of our believing these lies?
