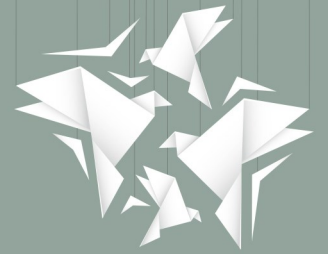


SPIRITUAL EXPATS (1 PETER 2:11-12)
