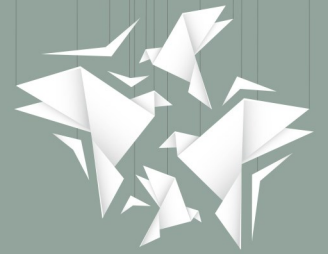


**THE “GOOD” LIFE (1 PETER 3:8-12)**
