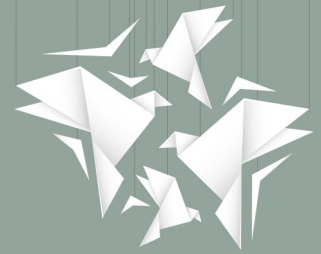
SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS
