- What remarkable things do we see about the people in this passage?

- Moses' mother entrusted him to God by placing him in the Nile. How have the circumstances of your life been affected by trust in God?
- When Moses is drifting in the river, his sister kept a watchful eye on him. Can we learn anything about trusting God and actively living out that trust from this story?
- Each of the women in Exodus 2 took action with no guarantee that Moses would be delivered. Why do we sometimes fail to act in small ways? What are some small things you can do this week in obedience to God?
