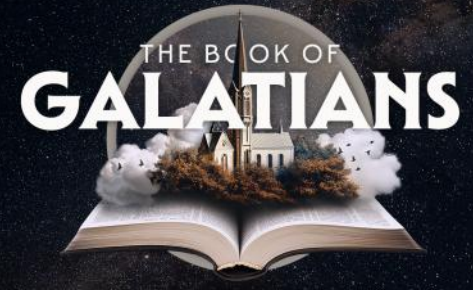


(The Gospel That Sets Us Free Pt 2—Galatians 1:6-10)
