**LETTERS DON'T COME AND GO AS MUCH AS THEY USED TO IN THE DAYS BEFORE THE INTERNET, BUT PEOPLE STILL SEND ONE ANOTHER MESSAGES, ON PAPER, OR ELECTRONICALLY, TO SHARE INFORMATION, STORIES, AND ENCOURAGEMENT, JUST AS THEY DID IN THE DAYS OF THE EARLY CHURCH.**
